2 INFORMATIONAL ITEM: REVIEW AND DISCUSS FY 2019-2020 BUDGET

2.1 Draft FY 2019-2020 Budget.

Mr. Denton explained the structure of Frankfort Plant Board, the structure of the budget and necessary funding. He further reviewed the budget assumptions and advised that the budget total was down about \$5 million mostly due to \$4.8 million reduction in electric power costs. He further advised that there were no water or electric rate increases planned and that cable rates would only change based on programming cost increases.

Mr. Bradshaw joined the meeting at 1:37 p.m.

Mr. Mason noted that he wanted to know what specific costs increased, the number of new positions, if any, the amount from the sale of surplus items, changes capital expenditures and operating/administrative costs, and what new initiatives are in each department.

Mr. Denton explained the funding summary, and Mr. Hudson and Mr. McCullar reviewed specifics of the electric budget and addressed questions from the Board. Staff explained increases and decreases in their departmental budget as well as projects and initiatives for the 19-20 fiscal year.

Ms. Rosen noted a planned rebate program for electric customers.

Mr. Blair Johansen reviewed a presentation regarding the compensation plan review. Ms. Schneider explained reclassifications included in the budget as well as cost of living and policy increases proposed in the FY 19-20 budget.

Mr. Denton explained the funding summary, and Mr. Billings, Mr. Smith, and Ms. Roney reviewed and discussed specifics of the Water department and Water Treatment budget and addressed Board member questions. Ms. Lindsey discussed the marketing budget for water.

Ms. Rosen discussed a water fountain project for City/County schools and potential for business sponsors. She read a proposed resolution with Franklin County Health Department regarding the school water fountain project.

Mr. Denton explained the funding summary, and Mr. Couch, Mr. Hellard and Mr. Stafford reviewed and discussed the Cable/Telecommunications budget and addressed Board member questions.

Ms. Rosen gave a brief summation of items discussed in the meeting.
